- shares our passion to serve the village communities west of Cambridge and help us better do so across our team of volunteers but with relatively limited resources
- will take the lead in creating an innovative 'resource hub' with an emphasis on efficient operations as well as supportive administration
- bring IT and social media skills to the team and pass them on.

The Lordsbridge Team of Churches is in a group of 11 villages in an area of 45 square miles just west of Cambridge. We are a 'network of worshipping communities', 11 of which are based in the ancient parish churches and fulfil parish responsibilities, with more experimental and contemporary faith communities developing alongside. We have a growing reputation as a training-team and as a place for innovative practice-based thinking.

However, as we work with more people in more places, the complexity of what we do increases, and we need support to continue to do the basics well whilst freeing up energy for new ventures. In short, we want our administrative capacity to catch up with our missional vision.

So, we are looking for an operations manager to pioneer with us a new way of working. This post is for 12 hours a week on an initial 3-year contract, funded Ely Diocese's Growth Fund.
